Immigration Law Update

Current Developments in Immigration

Dear Julie,

This is the latest installment in our efforts to keep you apprised of the rapidly changing U.S. immigration environment. Some of the most recent changes could have a serious impact on you or your employees, and we urge you to communicate these changes to interested parties.

New I-9 Form Must Be Implemented on May 7, 2013

Attention all HR Professionals, this is a reminder that beginning May 7, 2013, employers must use the newest version of Form I-9 to verify the identity and employment authorization of individuals hired for employment in the United States. The new form can be found at www.uscis.gov. Employers are advised to carefully review the new I-9 instructions as well as the revised M-274, Handbook for Employers before implementing the new I-9. I-94 Automation Process Has Begun

As of April 30, 2013 U.S. Customs and Border Protection has begun the automation of Form I-94 at air and sea ports. Rollout of the new automated I-94 system is expected to be completed by May 21, 2013. When entering via sea or air, international visitors will no longer complete a paper form I-94 at entry. The elimination of paper I-94s is expected to improve efficiency and reduce customer wait times at these ports-of-entry. Those wishing to obtain a hard copy of their I-94 will still be able to access the I-94 at www.cbp.gov/I94.

DV Lottery Results Now Available

The 2014 Diversity Lottery Results are now available through the Entrant Status Check on the Diversity Lottery website. Applicants are cautioned that scam e-mails regarding the diversity lottery are frequently distributed at this time of the year. Applicants are advised that the Entrant Status Check system located at <https://www.dvlottery.state.gov/> is the only government-sponsored notification method.
